

March Newsletter "Due Season"

Greetings! It is hard to believe that March is here, it seems like yesterday I was writing January's newsletter and proclaiming the year of New Beginnings. Until then He is protecting "your investment" and waiting on your **"proper season."** If I am being double minded in an area, my harvest cannot come because I have not made up my mind and I am not focused on my goal. We have to examine ourselves and our lives and close out those things that are hindering our **"due season"**.

In Romans 4:21 it says, "And being fully persuaded that, what he had promised, he was able also to perform." He promised in Galatians 6:9 in "due season we would reap if we did not faint (give up). I challenge you to examine your heart and mind and determine if there are situations and circumstances in your life that you are not **"fully persuaded"** in. If you find that there are, then challenge yourself to seek God for His direction and be obedient to it even if it is not what you originally thought. God knows every obstacle, every area that could hurt us and if we just listen to Him; He will protect us and guide us through the course. We have to understand that just because situations and circumstances do not work out "exactly" as we had planned that it does not mean that God is not at work on our behalf, protecting us, guiding us and leading us in His perfect will for our lives and our destiny.

God always has your best interest in His hand and it is our responsibility to not give up because your harvest IS in view and about to manifest as you walk in obedience to your Father's voice. Walk into your "due season."
